



Note on the representation of Gypsy/Roma and Traveller (GTR) pupils within non-mainstream education in England

January 2016

The Traveller Movement analysed Department for Education statistics detailing <u>pupil population characteristics in</u> January 2015 across England.

Below are two graphs that illustrate our findings. Pupil referral units (PRUs) and alternative provision (AP) are for pupils who, for a number of different reasons, cannot attend mainstream school. Commonly, pupils who receive school exclusions will attend a PRU or AP. The data shows that GTR pupils are disproportionately represented within the population of pupils attending PRUs and alternative provision.
